Join us for a special science storytelling adventure! Come to a land where dragons live in towers of ice, wolves sneeze down houses, and science tells the rest of the story!

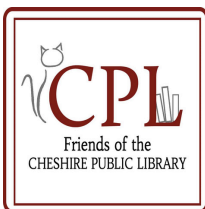

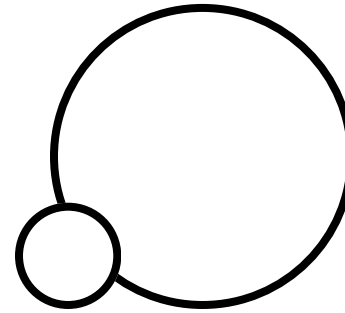
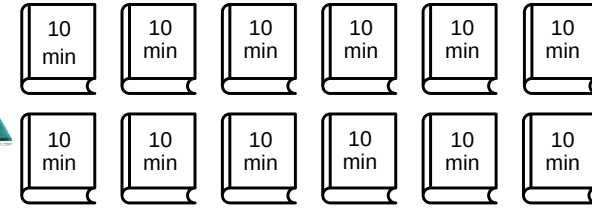


Town Wide Scavenger Hunt

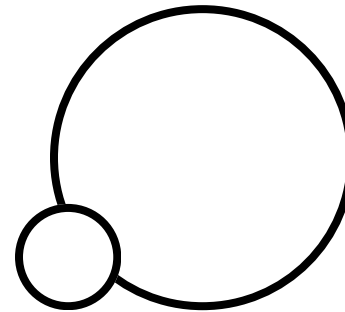
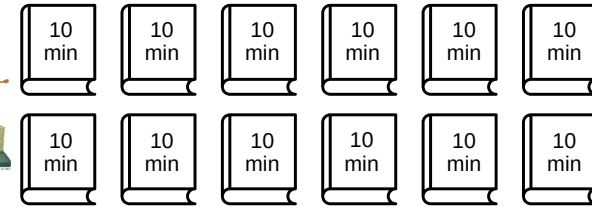
Say yes to visiting this store if you need to dress up for a very special occasion.

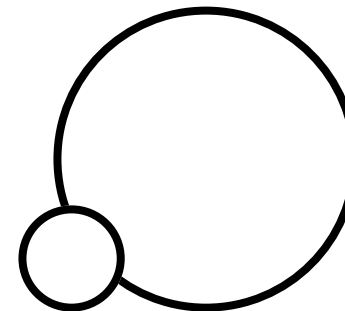
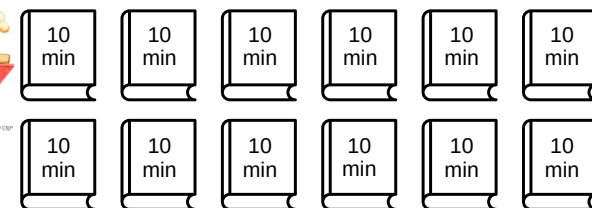
- Draw a map of a real or imaginary place.
